The apostle Paul had a surprising choice in expressing his identity.

- He had options.
- Our culture today would have options, as well.
- Paul's choice was "doulos" – a bond-slave – of Jesus Christ.

Paul in his writing exuded confidence.

- Of what was he confident?

 - He knew the One who began the good work.
 - He knew and loved the people.

- What did Paul want to have happen to their love?
